It is compact, economical, elegant, and designed with the Goldring insistence on precision and quality.

The good looks speak for themselves.

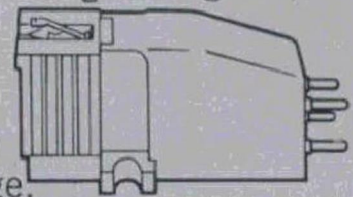
The unit is a two-speed integrated turntable unit – and the pick-up arm is of transcription quality, counterbalanced with a removable plug-in head.

The drive is from a specially designed low-speed synchronous motor via a non-stretch belt.

Other features include:

Adjustable anti-skating device.
Viscously damped cue-ing mechanism.
Performance to DIN 45-500. Wow and flutter at 0.15% peak.

Featured here is a cartridge designed, like the turntable itself, to bring out the very best performance from budget Hi-Fi. The G 850 stereo magnetic cartridge.
