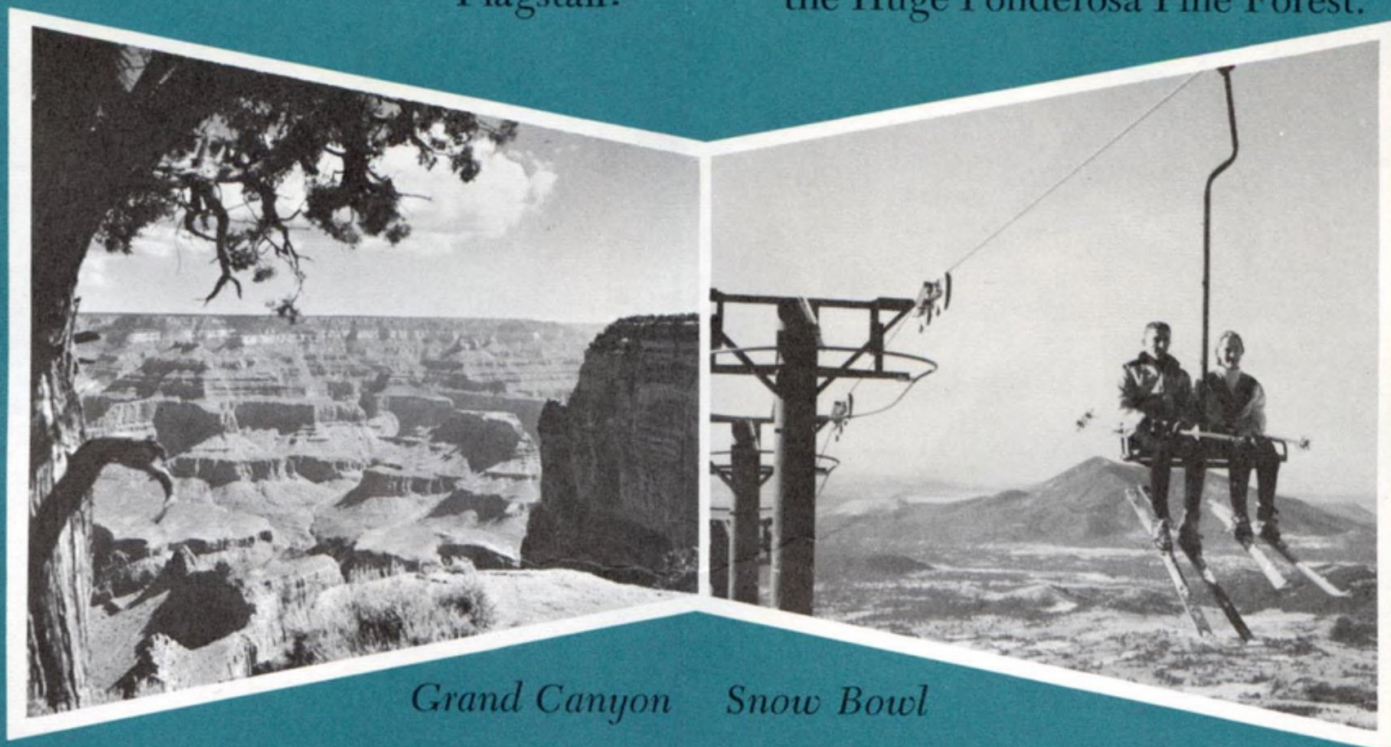

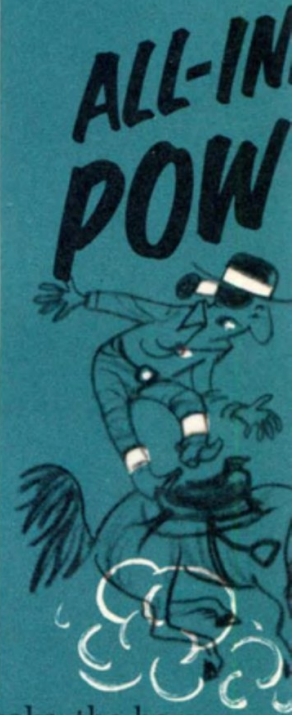
The most varied natural and historical attractions in the world surround Flagstaff.

Grand Canyon Snow Bowl



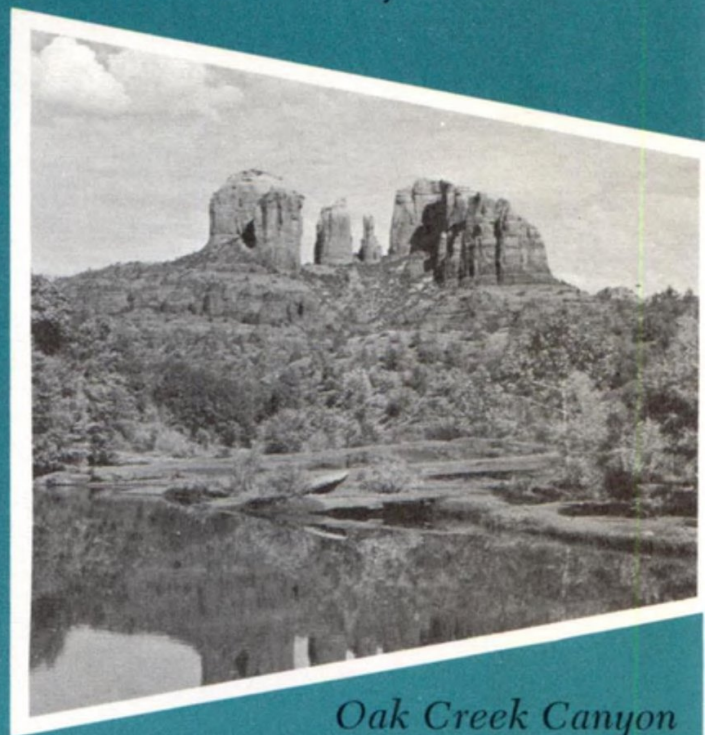
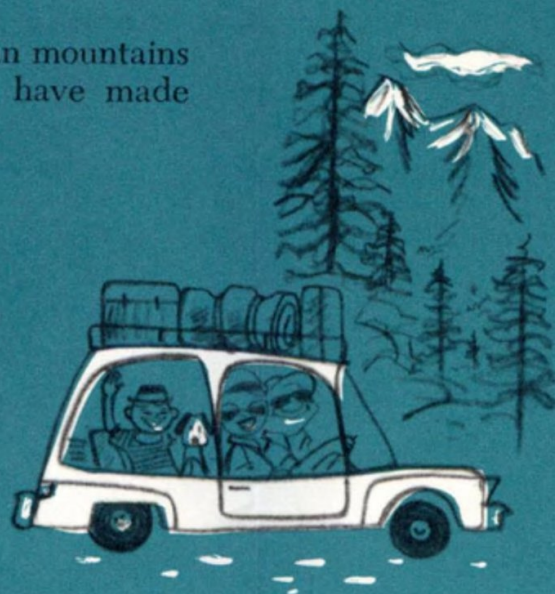

FACTS and FIGURES

POPULATION — City, 26,500; Trade area, 75,000.

HEALTH CONDITIONS — Altitude, sunshine, dust-free air, pine forests and low humidity combine to make Flagstaff beneficial for asthma, hay fever and most sinus conditions. Pollen count is less than 1 percent. Excellent community hospital. Many fine doctors. Consult your physician concerning effect of altitude on specific conditions.

CHURCHES — 48 are active.

EDUCATION — Northern Arizona University (four-year liberal arts); 2 High Schools; 2 Junior High Schools; 8 Public Elementary Schools; 2 Catholic Elementary Schools (grades 1-8). Museum of Northern Arizona, Lowell Observatory, Flagstaff Public Library, Community Concert Series, and Northern Arizona Symphony Orchestra, Pioneers' Historical Museum.

ORGANIZATIONS — Approximately 235 clubs and organizations, 45 of which are civic or fraternal.

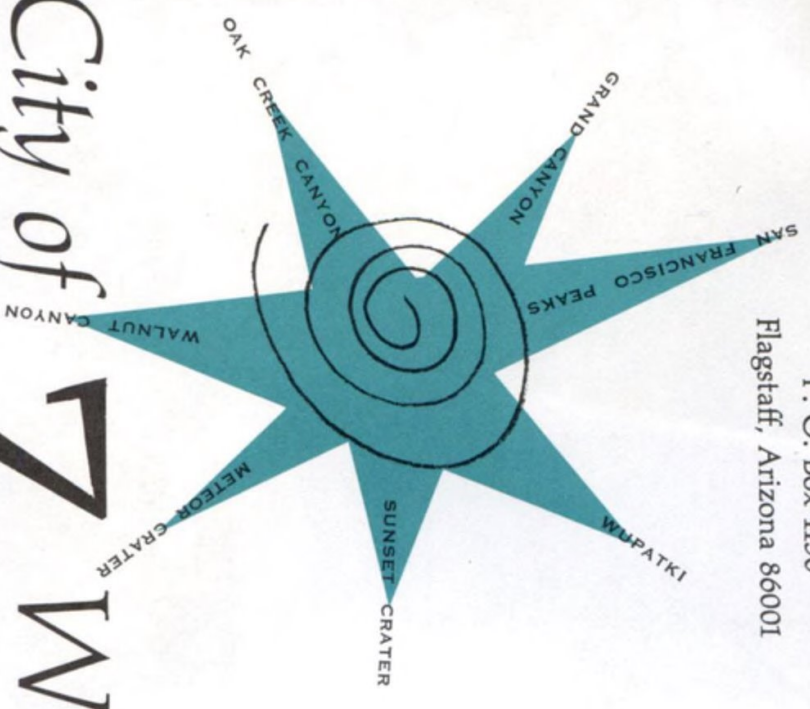
